Explanation of DNA Test Result

Dyserythropoietic Anemia and Myopathy Syndrome (DAMS) is autosomal recessive. "Clear" dogs have two normal copies of DNA. Clear dogs will not develop DAMS as a result of the *EHBP1L1* mutation, although we cannot exclude the possibility they might develop DAMS due to other mutations they might carry that are not detected by this test.
